The chosen individual will have high autonomy, leadership, and skills in managing and coordinating material resources, employees, subcontractors, and other third-party suppliers.

Main Responsibilities

- Act as the main contact person to all Mi'gmaq subcontractors and specialists providing guidance as required.
- Ensure that employment of qualified Mi'gmaq members is maximized.
- Plan for, prepare and execute along with Innergex Project Director ongoing communication with all stakeholders (Innergex team, Mi'gmaq Chiefs, leaders, elders, and members, interests' groups, etc.)
- Ensure the transfer of expertise, tools, and knowledge to the Mi'gmaq pertaining to the project management of the development and construction phases of a wind energy project.

Job Requirements

- Bachelor of Business Administration, or a combination of education and minimum experience required.
- Minimum five (5) years of management experience that includes a track record of managing large-scale projects.
